

Removing index.html from the Helix ALM Web URL

Note: The following information applies only to Helix ALM Web (and TestTrack Web 2013.1 - 2016.1) configured on IIS 6.

When Helix ALM Web is installed, the index.html file is added to the ttweb directory in the IIS document folder (e.g., wwwroot). The URL used to access Helix ALM Web must include this filename. For example:

`http://www.mycompany.com/ttweb/index.html`

To eliminate index.html from the URL, you can make it a default document in IIS. For example, the URL can be shortened to:

`http://www.mycompany.com/ttweb`

Refer to the [IIS 6 Setting Default Directories help](#) for additional information.

Note: Apache and other supported IIS versions include index.html as a default page by default. No additional configuration is required.
