

Surround SCM RDBMS Support

The Surround SCM Server database and mainline branches are stored in a Relational Database Management Systems (RDBMS). Following are the supported platforms, database vendors, and versions for the current version of Surround SCM.

See the [installation help](#) for information about setting up RDBMS databases.

Note: PostgreSQL is bundled in the Surround SCM installer. You can install PostgreSQL when installing the Surround SCM Server for the first time if the PostgreSQL version supports the operating system version. Regardless of the RDBMS, make sure the version you use is supported on the operating system you are installing it on. See the RDBMS vendor documentation for information about supported operating systems.
